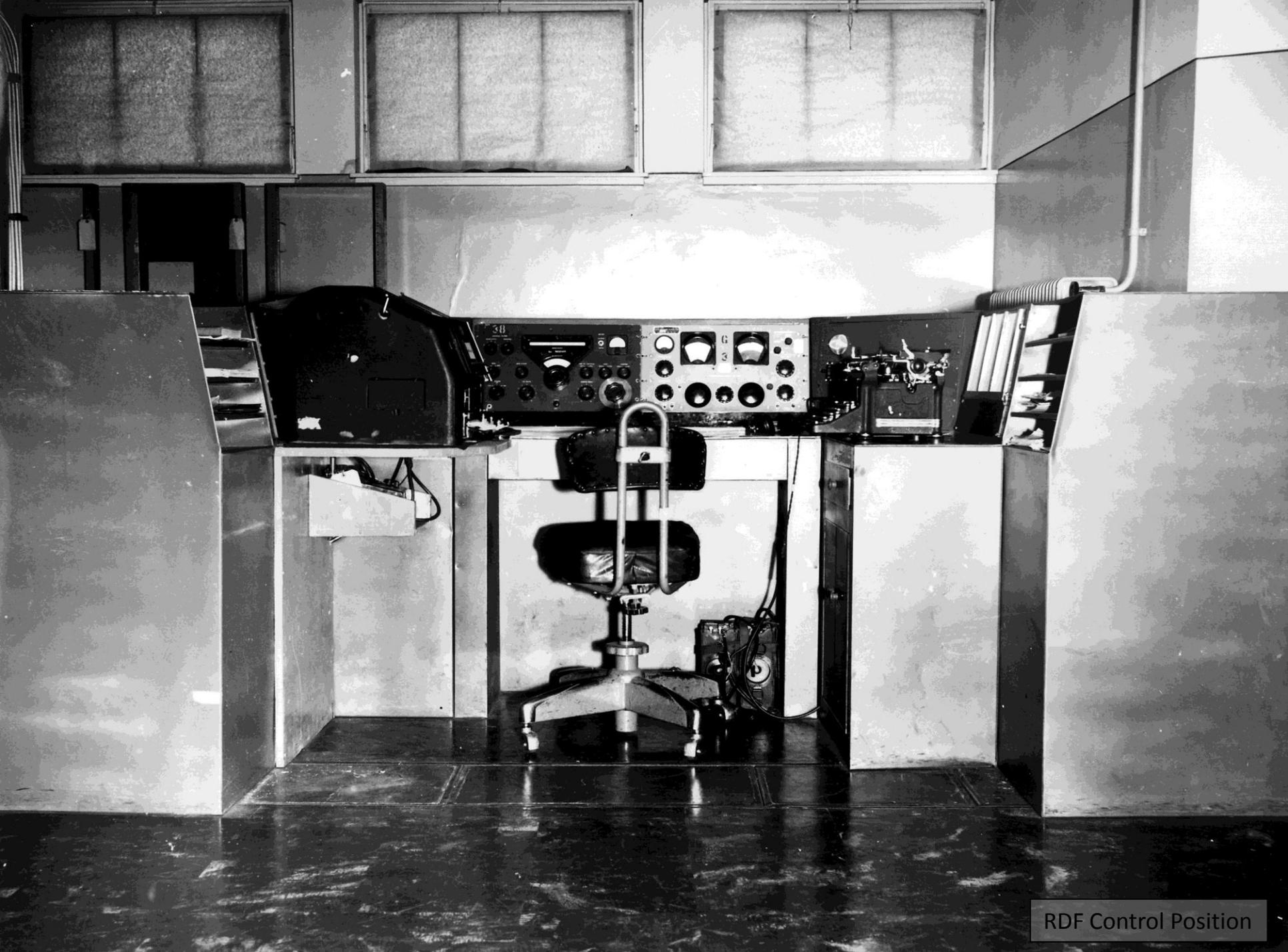

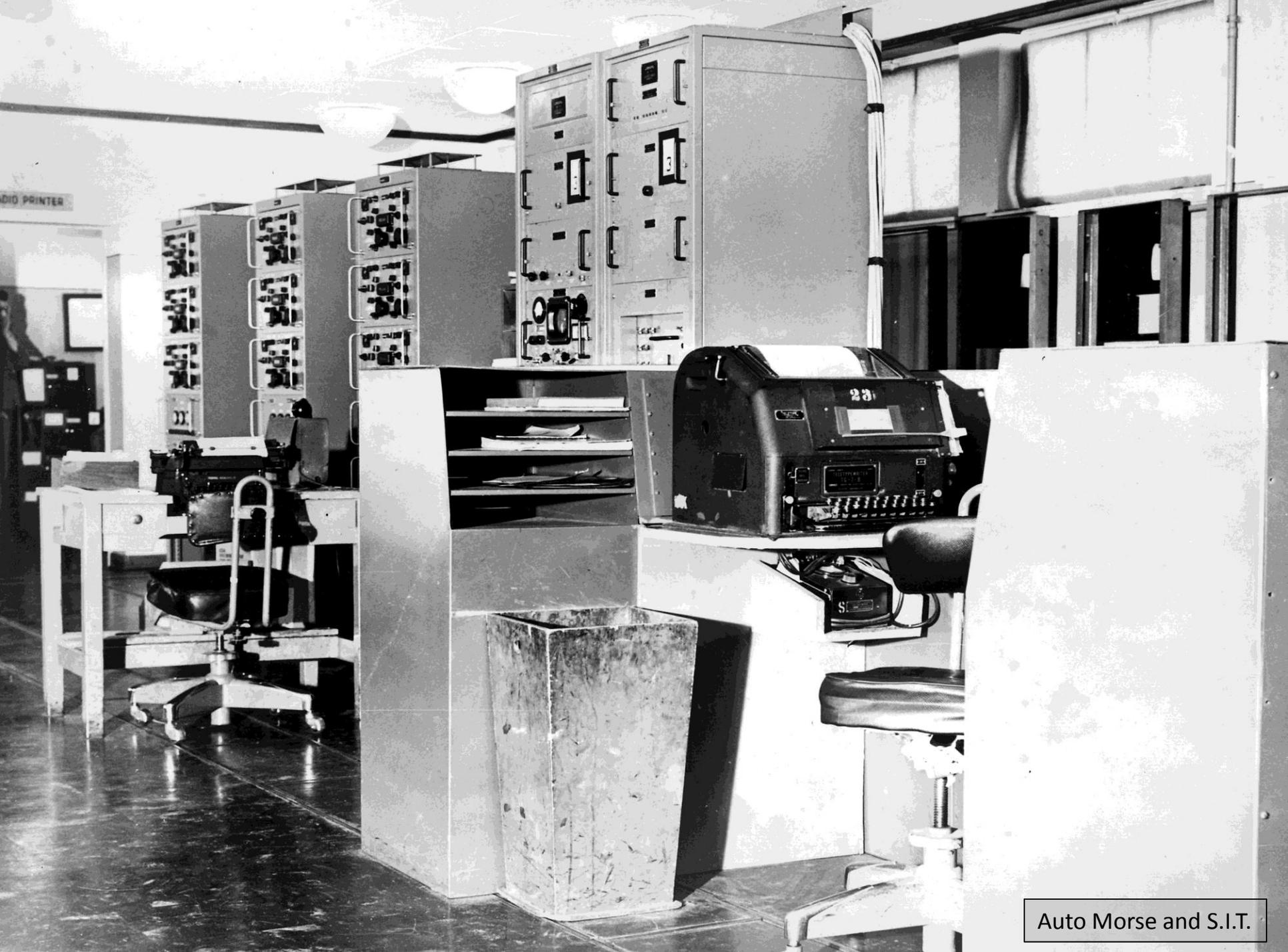

LINEAGE & HONORS

6911 RADIO GROUP, MOBILE

The 6911th Radio Squadron, Mobile was organized¹ on 8 May 1955 at Darmstadt, Germany, subordinate to the 6910th Security Group. It was redesignated² the 6911th Radio Group, Mobile on 1 Sep 1956, resubordinated to 6100 Security Wing on 9 Sep 1956, and discontinued³ on 15 May 1961.

This unit cannot be revived.

¹Organize: From 1944-1968, the lineal term “organize” is To assign personnel to a non-constituted unit.

²Redesignate: To change the official name of a unit.

³Discontinued: To withdraw all personnel from an organization and transferred to the inactive list, after being discontinued. Term used only during the period 1959-1968.

NOTE: Four digit units were **provisional** units and not *constituted permanent* units. Once inactivated, their histories and lineage ended forever--not to be used again.

ADDITIONAL NOTE: Public websites state the 6911th RSM and RGM are related to the 2d RSM and the 6911th Security Squadron, Mobile. This is incorrect. Both of these units (2 RSM/6911 SSM) are part of the current 402d Intelligence Squadron’s lineage. The 6911 RSM/RGM history began in 1955 and ended in 1961. It is very possible personnel, equipment, and policy were taken from 2 RSM and later ended up moving to 6911 SSM. This is considered a “functional” history, which is not recognized as official lineage.
